

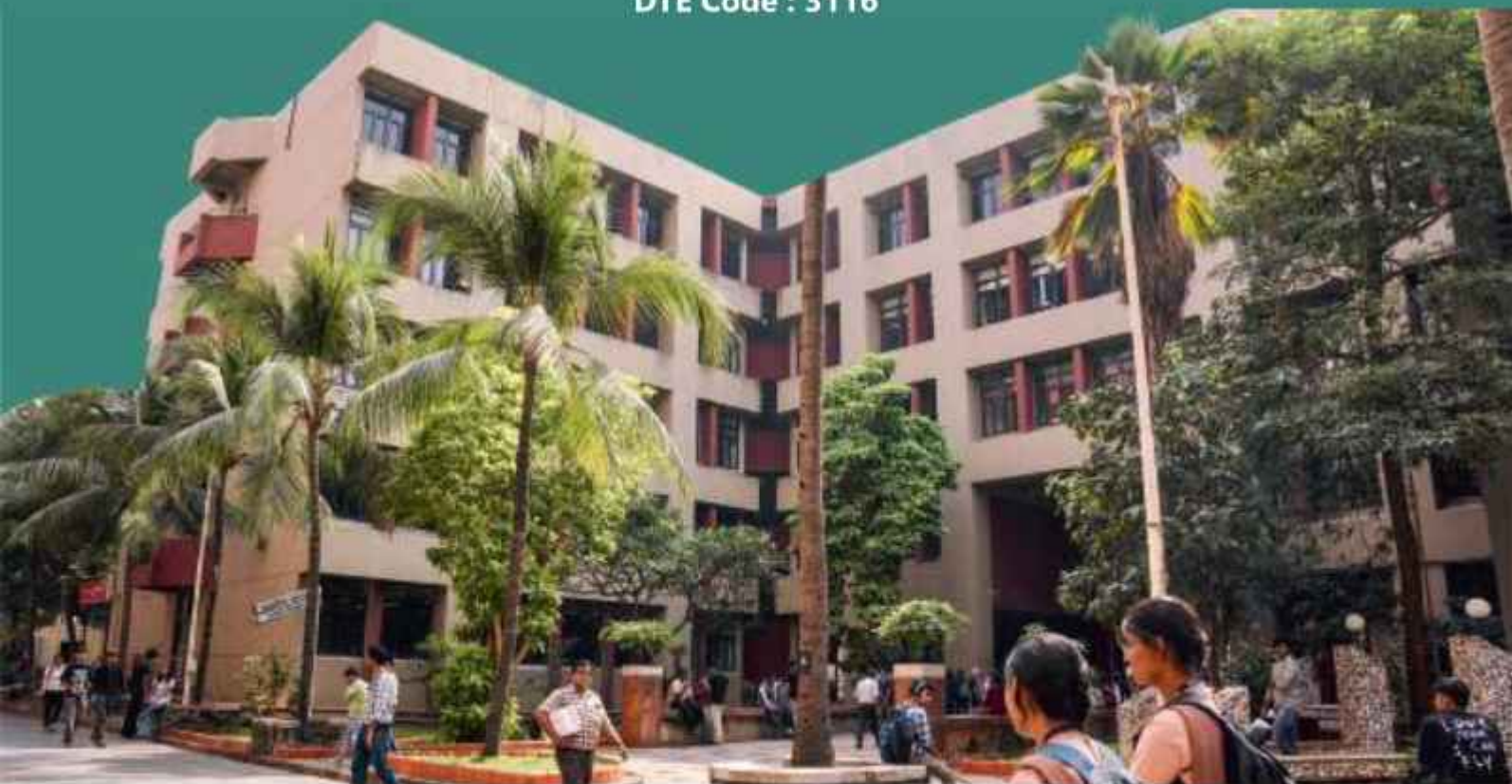

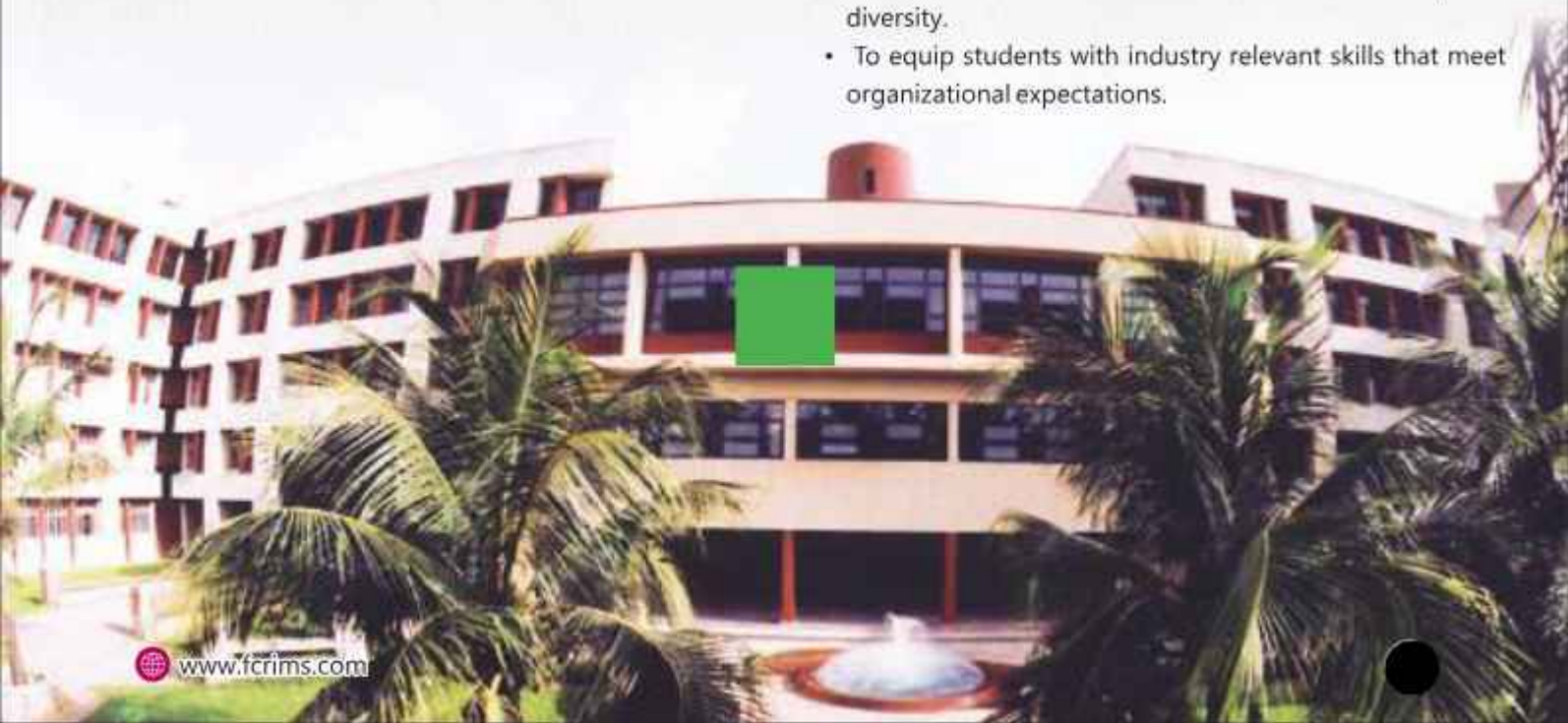

ABOUT MASTER OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES (M.M.S)

The academic program of the institute is a four- semester program leading to the Master of Management Studies Degree, awarded by the University of Mumbai. These four semesters are spread over two years. Between the second and third semesters students spend eight weeks working with organizations either as Interns or as researchers conducting Research in a particular business application.

During the first year of the programme, comprising the first and second semesters, five subjects are common to all students and three subjects are Electives for each semester. (Please see the course list) During these semesters they do basic courses in different areas of management practices like Finance, Human Resources and Organization, Marketing, Operations, as well as associated disciplines like Economics, Statistics and Law among others.

During the program students are required to select an area of management in which they wish to specialize. Currently the program offers the following areas of specialization:

- Finance
- Marketing
- Operations
- Human Resources

Students are required to take courses pertaining to their specialized area. In each course they must work on practical projects, in addition to their study of theory and concepts usually tested by quizzes, tests, presentations and examinations. In addition to Specialization area courses, all students are required to take some core subjects and relevant electives.

While knowledge building is implicit in any educational venture, we also focus very heavily on skill building. Students are required to present, before an audience, their views and knowledge on various topics. They thus become better thinkers and communicators. The development of students' Communication Skills is aided by a course on Business Communications that they are required to undergo. Since most courses are accompanied by practical projects students are properly grounded in business reality and develop good skills of analysis and judgment.
